We have met <u>before</u> . ^{Adv}	We met <u>(before lunch)</u> .
They play <u>outside</u> . ^{Adv}	It is <u>(outside the door)</u> .
Step <u>aboard</u> . ^{Adv}	Step <u>(aboard the train)</u> .
They marched <u>past</u> . ^{Adv}	I drove <u>(past them)</u> .
